## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the exclusive
- 2 legislative duty to support and maintain an efficient system of
- 3 public schools.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1, Article VII, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1. A general diffusion of knowledge being essential to
- 8 the preservation of the liberties and rights of the people, it shall
- 9 be the duty of the Legislature of the State to establish and make
- 10 suitable provision for the support and maintenance of an efficient
- 11 system of public free schools. The duty imposed by this section is
- 12 the sole prerogative of the Legislature. Notwithstanding the rights
- 13 and duties imposed by Article V of this constitution, the judicial
- 14 branch of the State has no authority to interfere or issue a
- 15 judgment or opinion on the actions of the Legislature implementing
- 16 this section.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 21 exclusive legislative duty to support and maintain an efficient
- 22 system of public free schools."
