A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to nullify an order, rule, policy, or similar measure adopted by the
- 3 executive branch of the federal government that exceeds the
- 4 authority granted by the United States Constitution.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 68 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 68. The legislature without the approval of the
- 9 governor may nullify an executive order, agency rule or policy, or
- 10 similar measure adopted by an official or entity within the
- 11 <u>executive branch of the federal government, if the legislature by a</u>
- 12 vote of two-thirds of the membership of each house determines that
- 13 the order, rule, policy, or measure exceeds the authority granted
- 14 to the executive branch by the United States Constitution. An
- order, rule, policy, or measure nullified by the legislature has no
- 16 legal effect in this state and may not be enforced or recognized as
- 17 having legal effect by this state or a political subdivision of this
- 18 state.
- 19 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 23 legislature to nullify an order, rule, policy, or similar measure
- 24 adopted by an official or entity within the executive branch of the

- 1 federal government that exceeds the authority granted to that
- 2 branch by the United States Constitution."
