A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment dedicating certain revenue

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 7-c to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 7-c. Subject to legislative appropriation,
- 8 allocation, and direction, all net revenues remaining after payment
- 9 of all refunds allowed by law and expenses of collection derived
- 10 from the following sources shall be used only for the acquisition of
- 11 rights-of-way for and the construction and maintenance of public
- 12 roadways other than toll roads:
- 13 (1) fees for permits that authorize a motor vehicle or
- 14 combination of motor vehicles that exceed the weight or size limits
- 15 allowed by this state to operate on a highway in this state;
- 16 (2) tolls collected or received in excess of the
- 17 amount pledged for debt obligations from a toll project or system
- 18 that is part of the state highway system;
- 19 <u>(3) payments received under a comprehensive</u>
- 20 <u>development agreement for a toll project or system;</u>
- 21 (4) the sale or transfer of any interest in a highway
- 22 right-of-way or real property acquired for a state highway purpose
- 23 that is no longer needed for a state highway purpose; and
- 24 (5) the sale of surplus motor vehicles by state

- 2 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 3 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 4 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 5 proposition: "The constitutional amendment dedicating certain
- 6 revenue sources to be used for the acquisition of rights-of-way for
- 7 and the construction and maintenance of public roadways."
