## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to increase the minimum amount
- 2 that the state may contribute to the Employees Retirement System of
- 3 Texas and the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 67(b)(3), Article XVI, Texas
- 6 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (3) The amount contributed by a person participating
- 8 in the Employees Retirement System of Texas or the Teacher
- 9 Retirement System of Texas shall be established by the legislature
- 10 but may not be less than six percent of current compensation. The
- 11 amount contributed by the state may not be less than seven [six]
- 12 percent nor more than 10 percent of the aggregate compensation paid
- 13 to individuals participating in the system. In an emergency, as
- 14 determined by the governor, the legislature may appropriate such
- 15 additional sums as are actuarially determined to be required to
- 16 fund benefits authorized by law.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2015.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to improve the
- 21 actuarial soundness of the Employees Retirement System of Texas and
- 22 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas by authorizing an increase
- 23 in the minimum amount of the state's annual contribution to the
- 24 Employees Retirement System of Texas and the Teacher Retirement
