WHEREAS, His father was a chemical engineering professor at The University of Texas at Austin and was renowned for purchasing the instruments for the first Longhorn Band and marching with them on the field; Eugene and Eugenia carried on the tradition of the family's support by establishing an endowment fund for the band and hosting band festivities in their home; and

WHEREAS, Eugene graduated from The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston and became a teaching medical fellow at Minneapolis General Hospital; he served with distinction as a captain and as a dermatologist in the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, He ran a successful dermatology practice in Austin for fifty-two years, during which time, his medical research was often published; he was a respected leader in his field and was a member of numerous professional organizations; he was asked to lecture at institutions around the country; and

WHEREAS, A loving husband, father, and grandfather, Dr. Schoch cherished time spent with his family; he was a man of
