**WHEREAS,** Clarence Muehlberger was born on May 31, 1921, in Wichita Falls; he graduated from Wichita Falls High School and earned a bachelor's degree in accounting from The University of Texas; and

**WHEREAS,** After graduation, he served his country in the Pacific Theater during World War II as an officer in the United States Navy; he returned home to join his father and grandfather in running a family clothing business, Muehlberger's Menswear, which he guided through 30 years of growth and success; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Muehlberger was inspired by the principles of his faith, and he served his community as an active member of numerous boards and organizations; he was dedicated to serving the Boy Scouts of America, was a master Mason, and served as an officer of the Wichita Falls Rotary Club; and

**WHEREAS,** He is noted for the many years he worked diligently to improve transportation in North Texas; in 2001, he was awarded the Texas Road Hand Award for his efforts to bring an interstate to Wichita Falls; it is the highest honor the Texas Department of Transportation gives a private citizen; and

**WHEREAS,** Clarence Muehlberger was a loving husband, father, and grandfather, and he leaves behind memories that will
