WHEREAS, Mrs. Knisely actively supported her husband while he earned his doctoral degree in anatomy at the Medical College of South Carolina, and she was his partner and confidante as he pursued a career in academic administration; they were blessed with five children, and the family moved throughout the United States as Mr. Knisely took on leadership roles at prominent universities; they lived in Austin during the 1960s and moved back to Austin in 1994; and

WHEREAS, She was dedicated to her work as a homemaker and raised her children with an energetic and loving hand; she was known for her outstanding cooking and knitting skills, and she produced innumerable blankets, scarves, and sweaters for her nine grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren; and
