WHEREAS, She joined the Office of Court Administration in 2001; as chief financial officer, she has provided day-to-day direction and guidance on financial, human resources, and operational activities, and she has worked collaboratively with the Texas courts to develop a consolidated budget for the Legislative Appropriation Request for each session; and

WHEREAS, A highly respected financial administrator, Glenna Bowman is a member of numerous professional organizations and has been recognized for excellence in her field; her presence at the Office of Court Administration will be greatly missed; now, therefore, be it
