IN RE: HB172 by Stickland (Relating to municipal regulation of electric stun guns, knives, and personal defense sprays.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to prohibit a municipality from adopting or enforcing regulations relating to the private ownership, keeping, carrying transporting, licensing, or registration of an electric stun gun, a knife, or a personal defense spray. The bill would provide certain exceptions as defined by the provisions of the bill.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
