**IN RE:** **HB266** by Miles (Relating to offenses involving violating the civil rights of a person in custody and engaging in improper sexual activity with a person in custody; providing certain enhanced penalties.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Penal Code to enhance the penalty for the offense of improper sexual activity with a person in custody under certain circumstances. This analysis assumes implementing the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional agencies, programs, or workloads.
