**IN RE: HB428** by Howard (Relating to allowing a person who will be 18 years of age on the date of the general election for state and county officers to vote in the preceding primary elections.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Election Code to allow certain persons to vote in certain elections.

The Secretary of State indicates that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

The bill would take effect on the date on which the constitutional amendment proposed by the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, authorizing this act takes effect.
