IN RE: **HB473** by Giddings (Relating to a prohibition on the sale or transfer of certain law enforcement vehicles before removal of certain equipment and insignia.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to prohibit certain state agencies from selling or transferring a marked patrol car to certain entities unless the law enforcement equipment or insignia has been removed from the vehicle.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to prohibit a municipality or a county from selling or transferring a marked patrol car to certain entities unless the law enforcement equipment or insignia has been removed from the vehicle.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
