**IN RE: HB473** by Giddings (Relating to a prohibition on the sale or transfer of certain law enforcement vehicles before removal of certain equipment and insignia.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to prohibit certain state agencies from selling or transferring a marked patrol car to the public unless the law enforcement equipment or insignia has been removed from the vehicle.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to prohibit a municipality or a county from selling or transferring a marked patrol car to the public unless the law enforcement equipment or insignia has been removed from the vehicle.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
