IN RE: HB497 by Wu (Relating to the applicability of the law governing saltwater pipeline facilities located in the vicinity of public roads.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Natural Resources Code to expand the definition of a "saltwater pipeline facility." Based on the analysis of the Railroad Commission, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
