IN RE: HB563 by Dutton (Relating to the prosecution of and punishment for the offense of official oppression.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Penal Code to enhance the penalty for the offense of official oppression under certain circumstances.
