**IN RE:** **HB595** by Clardy (relating to the addition of certain substances to Penalty Groups 1-A and 2 of the Texas Controlled Substances Act for criminal prosecution and other purposes.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to add certain substances to Penalty Groups 1A and 2 for criminal prosecution and other purposes. This analysis assumes the provisions of the bill related to criminal penalties would not result in a significant impact on state correctional agencies.
