**IN RE:** HB635 by Price (Relating to the disposition of fetal remains.), As Engrossed

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to require a hospital to release the remains in certain fetal deaths to parents of the unborn child upon request and in a manner that is appropriate under law and the hospital's policy.
