**IN RE: HB1018** by Geren (Relating to the prohibition of certain alcoholic beverages; creating an offense.), **As Introduced** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code to classify powdered alcohol as an illicit beverage and would prohibit the serving of powdered alcohol and certain other alcoholic beverages.

The bill would take effect on September 1, 2015.
