**IN RE: HB1060** by Rodriguez, Justin (Relating to reporting of teacher turnover information by public schools.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would exempt school districts from reporting teacher turnover for teachers who have completed a two-year teaching commitment as part of a program for underserved or low-income communities.

The Texas Education Agency anticipates that any additional work resulting from the passage of the bill could be reasonably absorbed within current resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
