**IN RE: HB1114** by Gonzales, Larry (Relating to the authority with whom certain political committees must file reports of political contributions and expenditures.), **As Introduced** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Election Code to require specific-purpose committees created to support or oppose a measure on the issuances of bonds by a school district to file reports with the Ethics Commission. The agency estimates there would be a minimal cost associated with implementing the provisions of the bill. It is assumed that these costs could be absorbed within existing resources.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2015.

#### Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
