IN RE: HB1180 by Burkett (Relating to certain information included on a searchable database on the Department of Family and Protective Services' Internet website.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 42 of the Human Resources Code and require the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) to maintain on the department's website a searchable database containing information on family homes meeting certain criteria.
