IN RE: **HB1184** by Paddie (relating to authorizing certain utility cost savings and alternative fuel programs as eligible for local government energy savings performance contracts.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to permit alternative fuel programs for local government vehicles and programs resulting in utility cost savings in energy savings performance contracts between local governments and certain providers.
