IN RE: HB1184 by Paddie (Relating to authorizing certain utility cost savings and alternative fuel programs as eligible for local government energy savings performance contracts.), Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Local Government Code definitions related to energy savings performance contracts, including provisions related to utility cost savings, a contract related to a pilot program described in the bill and certain alternative fuel programs. Texas A&M reports that no significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated as a result of the bill.
