IN RE: HB1329 by Naishtat (Relating to the payment of costs incurred by the involuntary commitment of persons with mental illness.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to prohibit a county from paying for the costs of certain hearings or proceedings related to the involuntary commitment of persons with mental illness with certain fees collected under Section 51.704, Government Code.
