IN RE: HB1524 by Farrar (Relating to the languages in which certain labor and employment notices and forms must be provided.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Labor Code relating to the languages in which certain labor and employment notices and forms must be provided. Based on information provided by the Texas Workforce Commission and Texas Department of Insurance, it is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
