**IN RE: HB1559** by Parker (Relating to public school Internet website information concerning local programs and services available to assist homeless students.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require certain schools that maintain an Internet website to post information regarding local programs and services, including charitable programs and services, available to assist homeless students.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. School districts may incur some costs associated with compiling and posting information related to assisting homeless students.
