IN RE: **HB1740** by Thompson, Senfronia (Relating to the administration of rabies vaccine under a local rabies control program.), **As Engrossed**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize certain veterinarians, who do not have a veterinarian-client-patient relationship with an animal, to administer or supervise the administration of a rabies vaccine.
