**IN RE:** **HB1790** by Márquez (Relating to job performance on behalf of a fire fighter or police officer who is recovering from an off-duty injury.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to prohibit a municipality from requiring certain firefighters or police officers from using accumulated time or placing the employee on a temporary leave if another police officer or firefighter volunteers to do the work of the injured firefighter or police officer until the employee returns to duty.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
