IN RE: HB1969 by Martinez, "Mando" (Relating to the issuance of certain permits for the movement of oversize or overweight vehicles on certain highways.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Section 623.322, Transportation Code, to add four additional routes to the oversize/overweight (OS/OW) vehicle corridor for which the Hidalgo County Regional Mobility Authority is authorized to issue permits under an agreement with the Texas Transportation Commission.

Based on the information provided by the Texas Department of Transportation, it is assumed any costs or duties associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within existing resources.

Local Government Impact

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
