IN RE: HB2040 by Tinderholt (Relating to professional development requirements for teachers of gifted and talented students.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require a teacher who provides instruction as part of a gifted and talented program to complete six hours of professional development every five years in gifted education specific to the subject the teacher instructs.
