IN RE: HB2232 by Kuempel (Relating to the creation of regional military sustainability commissions for certain military installations.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 397A.052 of the Local Government Code to permit certain counties and municipalities to create a regional military suitability commission. The bill would repeal Section 397A.052(d), Local Government Code.

Local Government Impact

It is assumed that eligible counties and municipalities would form a regional military sustainability commission if sufficient resources were available and if there was a need and benefit. At a minimum, the entities would incur costs to conduct the required public hearings and costs required for the commission to operate.
