IN RE: **HB2232** by Kuempel (Relating to the creation of regional military sustainability commissions for certain military installations.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 397A.052 of the Local Government Code to permit certain counties and municipalities to create a regional military suitability commission. The bill would repeal Section 397A.052(d), Local Government Code.

Local Government Impact

It is assumed that eligible counties and municipalities would form a regional military sustainability commission if sufficient resources were available and if there was a need and benefit. At a minimum, the entities would incur costs to conduct the required public hearings and costs required for the commission to operate.
