**IN RE: HB2499** by Thompson, Senfronia (Relating to the electronic filing of bail bonds in certain counties.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to permit bail bonds to be filed electronically with the court, judge, magistrate or other officer taking the bond.
