IN RE: HB2654 by Elkins (Relating to the authority of the Harris-Galveston Subsidence District to regulate certain water wells.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Special District Local Laws Code to specify certain permit requirements do not apply to a well that serves only a single-family dwelling and meets certain criteria.
