**IN RE:** **HB2784** by Faircloth (relating to the authority of certain counties to regulate camping on public beaches; adding a provision that may be subject to a criminal penalty.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Natural Resource Code to permit certain counties to regulate by order camping on a beach within the boundaries of the county. The bill would permit a county to define "camping" and restrict the length of time for which an individual may camp on a beach.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
