IN RE: HB2784 by Faircloth (Relating to the authority of certain counties to regulate camping on public beaches.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Natural Resource Code to permit certain counties to regulate by order camping on a beach within the boundaries of the county. The bill would permit a county to define "camping" and restrict the length of time for which an individual may camp on a beach.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
