IN RE: HB2899 by Parker (Relating to restrictions on branch office licenses and employees under the Private Security Act.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code pertaining to the Private Security Act to stipulate certain restrictions on branch office licenses and employees. It is assumed implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within current resources.
