**IN RE: HB2937** by Schofield (Relating to the cancellation of a person's voter registration on notice that the person has acknowledged that the person is not a citizen.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Election Code to direct the voter registrar to immediately cancel a voter's registration upon receipt of a certain list of individuals disqualified from jury service because of citizenship status. The bill would require a voter registrar to send a notification to the voter if a voter's registration is cancelled due to citizenship status. The bill would require a registrar and clerk to submit certain information to parties regarding the citizenship of voters.

The bill would repeal Section 16.0332, Election Code.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
