**IN RE:** **HB3033** by Alvarado (Relating to the disciplinary suspension of a municipal firefighter in certain municipalities.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to require certain notices of disciplinary suspension to be to be personally served to a firefighter or sent by certified mail by the 180th day after the department discovers or becomes aware of the violation.
