IN RE: **HB3067** by Coleman (Relating to the amount that may be donated by contract by certain populous counties to crime stoppers or crime prevention organizations.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to permit certain commissioner courts to donate up to up to \$100,000 to one or more crime stoppers or crime prevention organization in a calendar year.
