**IN RE: HB3106** by Huberty (Relating to the period of time allowed for appointment of a board of managers for a school district.), **As Introduced** 

### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would authorize the Commissioner of Education, before the second anniversary of the date the board of managers of a district was appointed, to extend the authority of a board of managers for up to two additional years if the commissioner determines a district is making insufficient progress towards improving academic or financial perfomance.

### Local Government Impact

School districts could face additional costs for the board of managers if the commissioner decides to extend the board's authority.
