**IN RE: HB3122** by Faircloth (Relating to ballots counted by the early voting ballot board.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Election Code to extended the date that a local canvass and the counting of provisional ballots could be conducted. The bill would permit an election officer to petition a district court for injunctive or other relief if certain conditions exist relating to an incorrect rejection of a early voting ballot.

The Office of Court Administration reported no significant fiscal impact to the state court system is anticipated.
