**IN RE: HB3211** by King, Phil (Relating to training requirements for peace officers appointed to supervisory positions.), **As Introduced** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code to require a peace officer appointed to a supervisory position to receive certain training on supervision within a specified time frame. It is assumed any costs associated with implementing the bill could be absorbed within current resources. The bill would take effect September 1, 2015.

### **Local Government Impact**
