IN RE: **HB3220** by Martinez, "Mando" (Relating to the powers and duties of the Hidalgo County Water Control and Improvement District No. 18; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose fees and taxes; providing authority to participate in water planning and conservation projects related to the district within and outside district boundaries; and providing other powers related to roads, water, sewer, recycled water, and related utilities.), **As Introduced**
