**IN RE:** **HB3244** by Burkett (Relating to authorizing broker agreements for the sale of real property held in trust by home-rule municipalities.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to permit the governing body of certain municipalities to contract with a broker to sell a tract of real property that the municipality owns or holds in a trust and has the authority to sell.
