**IN RE:** **HB3245** by Crownover (Relating to qualified nonprofit corporations acting for and on behalf of two or more cities.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Education Code to authorize a nonprofit corporation to withdraw from acting on behalf of a municipality at the consent of the municipality's governing body. After the withdrawal, the municipality would be prohibited from involvement with certain functions of the nonprofit corporation.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
