**IN RE:** HB3368 by Thompson, Senfronia (Relating to the hours during which a holder of a retail dealer's on-premise late hours license may sell beer.), As Introduced

### No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code as it relates to the hours during which a holder of a retail dealer's on-premise late hours license may sell beer. The bill indicates the amendment is intended to clarify rather than change existing law. The bill would take effect immediately upon receiving a two-thirds majority vote in each house, otherwise the bill would take effect September 1, 2015.

#### **Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
