**IN RE:** **HB3640** by Guillen (Relating to fees of office for the directors of a municipal utility district.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Water Code to specify a director of a municipal utility district is entitled to receive a per diem of up to \$100 a day for each day the director spends performing the duties of a director. The bill would prohibit a per diem to exceed \$4,800 a year.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
