IN RE: **HB3668** by Workman (Relating to the definition of peace officer for purposes of intercepting or collecting information in relation to certain communications in an investigation conducted by an arson investigating unit.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to add a member of an arson investigating unit to a list of peace officers authorized to intercept or collect information in certain communications.
