**IN RE:** **HB3720** by Schubert (Relating to authorizing the Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District to use revenue from export fees to fund road and water infrastructure projects.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Special District Local Laws Code to permit the Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District to use money collected from export fees to design, operate, and maintain water infrastructure and graveled or paved roads. The bill sets forth procedures and requirements of roads constructed. The bill would require the Texas Transportation Commission to approve any plans and road projects that the state would maintain and operate.

**Local Government Impact**

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
